Principal's Report Digital Learning day - Feedback Saturday, Dec. 10 is school choice fair	Feedback survey was sent out this morning to ask how digital learning day went. Potential for a digital learning day if there is a snow day. Attendance was good. Students were given credit if they did any of their work or attended any meetings. Some families do not have internet access and this day will give the school information to be able to support those families in gaining internet access. Students at DC were not able to get on meetings unless the kids signed themselves on. Amy-shared that it is difficult for teachers to find a balance between virtual meetings and independent work. Speaker: Sarah Bosch - Teacher Union rep role and Q & A Overview of role Q&A	Educators' work conditions are students' learning conditions- Class size was one sticking point in last years' contract negotiation. Language in the contract states that if class size goes over the limit, there has to be a meeting including principal, area superintendent, teacher, union steward, and 2 parents to decide what steps will be taken. -Puts extra support in place for that class so that high quality learning can take place for students and to prevent burnout for teacher. At HMS, there was an odd % split with only 5 5th graders in the class. Mr. Litwin adjusted class numbers which resulted in 2 5th grade classes going over. Committee voted to accept overage with additional supports for those classes. Concessions were an academic support educator full time, added an additional teacher assistant for 5th grade. Still posted and unfilled at this time with 0 applicants. This is the only instance in contract where parents/PTA have a voice in the decision making process. Support is appreciated whenever contract negotiations are happening.
Treasurer's Report	Abby-Some expenses from last year were not submitted until this school year, but Revenue this year is just over \$2,000, which is expected because biggest fundraisers have not yet happened (read-a-thon and auction) Working on setting up a process to spread out large expenses such as music teacher position. Jim-wondering if there is a PTA budget on the PTA website for when he is asked questions by staff. Also, he feels that transparency would be helpful as an organization raising money for the school. Abby-we will work on having this available on the website, but it is not
